



• Daily snack is provided • Closed when school closes due to weather • Scheduled early dismissals are included in daily fees • Care available to all District 100 Elementary schools • Sites are located at each school. Exceptions: *Perry students are bussed to Lincoln* • All registration forms in ePACT must be completed and submitted 24 hours before a child may attend • Space is limited and registration is on a first come, first paid basis • In the event of a late pick-up after 6 pm a \$10 per 15 minutes late fee will immediately apply

2022-23 3rd Base Registration*

Registration will be daily; your child must be registered for the week by the Wednesday at 11:59pm prior to the week attending. Your child must be registered and paid in advance to attend the program. There will be no options for drop-ins. **If school is canceled due to weather, you will receive a refund. If needed, you will be responsible for registering and paying for any Emergency School Days that are added to the school year, by the Wednesday prior to the week of attendance. The following dates are 2023 Emergency Days, if needed/used: 6/5 thru 6/9/23.

The registration deadline is Wednesday at 11:59pm prior to the week of attendance. All registration forms, health history and emergency contact must be completed and submitted before a child may attend. All information will be submitted through our online system – ePact.

3rd Base is a license exempt program. The Belvidere Park District follows the guidelines put in place by the Illinois Department of Human Services and accepts requests for childcare assistance from DCFS. Parents/ Guardians are responsible for registration fees until State of Illinois authorizes financial assistance.


Preschool

2022-23 Preschool Registration

Registration packets for 2022/2023 Belvidere Park District Preschool are available at Rivers Edge Recreation Center. To register, return the completed registration packet along with copy of a birth certificate and one month's payment of preschool, which secures your child's place and will be applied as your child's May payment. Monthly EFT payments will be withdrawn on the 1st of every month beginning September 1, 2022. Please note: There is a **one-time \$25** supply fee to cover most of the necessary supplies for preschool. *Payment made for the full year at time of registration will receive a 5% discount.* (KI)

Benefits to attending preschool

- Activities to develop fine motor strength, identify shapes of letters and begin learning how to write them
- Exposure to letter sounds to develop pre-reading skills
- Exposure and opportunity to gain knowledge in math and science concepts





Board Meetings

Board meetings are held the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month at 5:00 p.m. at the Baltic Mill Annex in Belvidere Park - 920 W. Lincoln Ave.

Park Hours

Park property hours are 6:00am to 10:00pm unless a Park District sponsored program is taking place.

Behavior Management Policy

All participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. The following guidelines have been developed to help make children's programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. Additional rules may be developed for specific programs as deemed necessary by staff. The Park District insists that all participants comply with a basic behavior code. All participants shall:

- Show respect to all participants, staff, and volunteers. Participants should follow program rules and take direction from staff.
- · Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, or staff.
- Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities.
- Not possess any weapons.

A positive approach will be used regarding discipline. Staff will periodically review rules with participants during the program session. If inappropriate behavior occurs, a prompt resolution will be sought specific to each individual's situation. The Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others. Upon registration or entry into the program, the parent/guardian should be solicited for any information regarding special accommodations needed for the participant. If any of these special accommodations are behavior related, the behavior medication programs in place at school or home. Attempts should be made to utilize these in the program. Also, Special Recreation should be contacted for guidance. Documentation should be maintained regarding any problem behaviors, special accommodations, and behavior modification programs.

Cell Phone Use

The use of cell phones in Park District restrooms or locker rooms is strictly prohibited.

Resident/Non-Resident Fee Policy

Belvidere Park District residents make significant contributions to the operation of the district through their property taxes. This contribution is beyond the program and service fees. Those patrons living outside the boundaries are required to pay the non-resident (NR) fee to equalize fee structures where applicable. Residents in the Belvidere Park District boundaries receive discounted resident program rates. Non-residents may register for programs for a fee that is 50% higher than the resident fee or \$15 over the resident fee, whichever is the smaller amount with the following exceptions: NASR programs, 3rd Base After School Care, facility/shelter rentals, field rentals, contracted trips, adult athletic team league fees, tournaments and daily admissions. Individuals registering for a class that requires parent (adult) and child participation if one of the participants resides in the Belvidere Park District boundaries, the resident fee will be charged.

The Belvidere Park District boundaries are:

North Boundary: South side of Orth Road •South Boundary: U.S. 20 by-pass West Boundary: Winnebago/Boone County line • East Boundary: Poplar Grove Rd. *Also included in the district boundaries are Farmington Fields, Wycliffe, Aderdeen Knolls and Oakbrook Woods subdivisions.


