

2023-24 Preschool Registration

Registration packets for 2023/2024 Belvidere Park District Preschool are available at Rivers Edge Recreation Center. To register, return the completed registration packet along with a copy of a birth certificate and one month's payment of preschool, which secures your child's place and will be applied as your child's May payment. Monthly EFT payments will be withdrawn on the 1st of every month beginning September 1, 2023. There is a one-time \$30 supply fee. (KI)



Board meetings are held the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month at 5:00 p.m. at the Baltic Mill Annex in Belvidere Park - 920 W. Lincoln Ave. *Only one meeting held in December due to the Holiday Season

Park property hours are 6:00am to 10:00pm unless a Park Districtsponsored program is taking place.

Behavior Management Policy

All participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. The following guidelines have been developed to help make children's programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. Additional rules may be developed for specific programs as deemed necessary by staff. The Park District insists that all participants comply with a basic behavior code. All participants shall:

- Show respect to all participants, staff, and volunteers. Participants should follow program rules and take direction from staff.
- Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, or staff.
- Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities.
- Not possess any weapons.

A positive approach will be used regarding discipline. Staff will periodically review rules with participants during the program session. If inappropriate behavior occurs, a prompt resolution will be sought specifically to each individual's situation. The Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others. Upon registration or entry into the program, the parent/guardian should be solicited for any information regarding special accommodations needed for the participant. If any of these special accommodations are behavior-related, the behavior medication programs in place at school or home. Attempts should be made to utilize these in the program. Also, Special Recreation should be contacted for guidance. Documentation should be maintained regarding any problem behaviors, special accommodations, and behavior modification programs.

Cell Phone Use

The use of cell phones in Park District restrooms or locker rooms is strictly prohibited.

Parks and Conservation Foundation

The Parks and Conservation Foundation may be just what you're looking for. Residents in the Belvidere Park District boundaries receive discounted resident program rates. Non-residents may register for programs for a fee that is 50% higher than the resident fee or \$15 over the resident fee, whichever is the smaller amount with the following exceptions: NASR programs, 3rd Base After School Care, facility/shelter rentals, field rentals, contracted trips, adult athletic team league fees, tournaments and daily admissions. Individuals registering for a class that requires parent (adult) and child participation if one of the participants resides in the Belvidere Park District boundaries, the resident fee will be charged.

The Belvidere Park District boundaries are:

North Boundary: South side of Orth Road •South Boundary: U.S. 20 bypass West Boundary: Winnebago/Boone County line • East Boundary: Poplar Grove Rd. *Also included in the district boundaries are Farmington Fields, Wycliffe, Aderdeen Knolls and Oakbrook Woods subdivisions.

Disc Golf Course

Belvidere's disc golf course is located in Belvidere Park. This 9-hole course is nestled throughout the park among mature trees and is fun for beginners and a challenge for experts. In various park locations, are available to rent, April through October. Shelter reservations must be accompanied by a reservation form and shelter payment. 
