FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Belvidere Township Park District believes every child should have access to recreational programs, regardless of financial circumstances. Thanks to First Mid Bank & Trust our new Financial Assistance Scholarship (FAS) Program helps cover registration fees for youth programs in sports, fitness, arts, and more, ensuring all kids can stay active and engaged.

Eligibility requirements for the applicant:

To qualify for the FAS program, families must meet the following criteria:

- The family resides within, or the child attends school within, the Belvidere Township Park District boundaries.
- The child is between ages 2-17 at the start of the program.
- The family's income meets the FAS Income Guidelines (outlined on the application).
- The families must contribute to the program cost (The contributions are 1/3 family, 2/3 Financial Assistance Scholarship).



Important Camp Details: Payments and paperwork must be completed before your child can attend. All registration forms, health history, and emergency contact information must be submitted through our online system-ePACT. Children should be registered for the grade they will be entering for the 2025/2026 school year. Registration Deadline: Your child must be registered by Monday at 11:59 PM the week prior to the week attending. Billing will happen weekly on Tuesdays prior to camp week starting. If payment is not received by Tuesday child will not be able to attend that week of camp. A parent/camper handbook containing our policies and procedures is available to all participants upon registration and can also be found online at www.belviderepark.org listed under programs CAMP. Campers should arrive no later than 9AM. Pick-up is anytime from 4-6 PM. In the event of a late pickup-up (after 6 PM), a \$15 for every 15 minutes late fee will immediately apply. Breakfast and an afternoon snack are provided daily. Breakfast is served to campers who arrive before 8:30AM. Please bring a lunch daily. If campers forget to bring a lunch, one will be provided for them and an \$8 fee will be applied to your account. Site is a nut-free program.

Third Base is a cooperative after-school recreation program between the Belvidere Park District and School District #100. Caring and trained staff provide a safe, healthy and fun environment for boys and girls in grades K-5. Our goal at Third Base is to encourage an environment of respect, community, fun and safety. Activities include group games, arts and crafts, homework time, and parties. The program operates until 6:00 PM on full days of school. • Care available to all District 100 elementary schools • Sites are located at each school. Exceptions: *Perry students are bussed to Lincoln* • All registration forms in ePACT must be completed and submitted 24 hours before a child may attend • Space is limited and registration is on a first come, first paid basis • In the event of a late pick-up after 6PM a \$15 per 15 minutes late fee will immediately apply.

2025/2026 3rd Base Registration*

Registration will be daily. Your child must be registered for the week by Wednesday at 11:59 PM prior to the week attending. Your child must be registered and paid in advance to attend the program. If payment is not made by Thursday, your child will not be eligible to attend 3rd Base that week. There will be no drop-ins. If school is cancelled due to weather, you will receive a credit. If needed, you will be responsible for registering and paying for any Emergency School Days. You must register by the Wednesday prior to the week of attendance for all emergency school days.

All registration forms, health history and emergency contact must be completed and submitted before a child may attend. All information will be submitted through our online system – ePACT at https://www.epactnetwork.com/login.

3rd Base programs are not licensed or regulated by the Department of Children and Family services (DCFS). However, the facility is considered "license-exempt". The Belvidere Park District follows the guidelines put in place by the Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) and accepts requests for childcare assistance from DCFS. Parents/guardians are responsible for registration fees until the State of Illinois authorizes financial assistance.



Board Meetings

Park Hours

Park property hours are 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM unless a Park Districtsponsored program is taking place.

Behavior Management Policy

All participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all

The following guidelines have been developed to help make children's programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. Additional rules may be developed for specific programs as deemed necessary by staff. The Park District insists that all participants comply with a basic behavior code. All participants shall

- Show respect to all participants, staff, and volunteers. Participants should follow program rules and take direction from staff.
- Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- Refrain from threatening or causing bodily harm to self, other participants, or staff.
- Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities.
- Not possess any weapons.

A positive approach will be used regarding discipline. Staff will periodically review rules with participants during the program session. If inappropriate behavior occurs, a prompt resolution will be sought specific to each individual situation. The Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers his or her own safety or the safety of others. If undesired behavior outcomes require a disability-related accommodation, the parent/guardian must request reasonable accommodations before participation. All accommodations will be made on a case-by-case basis. Contact the Special Recreation Manager at 815-547-5711 x600 to begin the accommodation process.

Cell Phone Use

The use of cell phones in Park District restrooms or locker rooms is strictly prohibited.

Parks and Conservation Foundation

The Parks and Conservation Foundation may be just what you're looking for. Established in 1992, the Parks and Conservation Foundation's mission is to assist the Belvidere Park District and the Boone County Conservation District to acquire and develop land. Firearms Concealed and Carry Act

Passed July 2013, this act forbids carrying a concealed weapon into governmental buildings and parks, which includes all Belvidere Park District facilities and parks. When you enter our facilities and parks, you will see signs posted at the entrances that are approved by the Illinois State Police to remind all patrons of the law.

Resident/Non-Resident Fee Policy

Belvidere Park District residents make significant contributions to the operation of the district through their property taxes. This contribution is beyond the program and service fees. Residents (R) receive discounted program fees. Patrons living outside the boundaries are required to pay the non-resident (NR) fee to equalize fee structures, where applicable. The following programs may not have different fee structures for residents and non-residents: special recreation, facility/shelter rentals, field rentals, contracted trips, adult athletic team league fees, tournaments and daily admissions. To qualify for the resident fee, the participant and/or their parent/guardian (where applicable) must be a resident in the Belvidere Park District boundaries.

North Boundary: South side of Orth Road •South Boundary: U.S. 20 bypass West Boundary: Winnebago/Boone County line • East Boundary: Poplar Grove Rd. *Also included in the district boundaries are Farmington Fields, Wycliffe, Aderdeen Knolls and Oakbrook Woods subdivisions.


